

The Gift of Life

What do we celebrate on Easter Sunday? We celebrate LIFE! The resurrection is God's affirmation amongst other things of life. It affirms the life God gives to all living things, that which he made, sustains and loves. It affirms the life he gives to men and women. We were made in his image and likeness, to be stewards of creation and to enjoy sweet fellowship with him and one another.

The resurrection is an affirmation of all of these things in the face of evil, sin and death, its great and seemingly final consequence. Sin affects and distorts every level of our being, physical, psychological, relational and spiritual. Ultimately it must and will be judged and is as Jesus gave his life for us, in our place, on the cross. The resurrection though shows us that in Christ God redeems us at every level of our being. Our physical being is not just a shell that gets discarded in death, a shell that appears to trap and ensnare our spiritual selves. Both are corrupt but worthy of redemption, which is what Jesus achieves for us in his resurrection.

SECURITY CHANGES



That you never could


I've taken your mess
