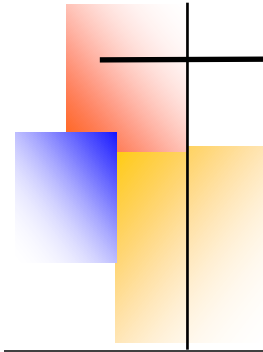

Old Church — New Life

1st October 2017

## John Wycliffe

Born: 1320s in Hipswell, Yorkshire

Died: 31 December 1384 in Lutterworth, Leicestershire

Manner of death: He died of a stroke in his sixties. Sadly though the church had his body exhumed and the ashes burnt and thrown into the river swift.

Significant Contribution: Wycliffe's Bible

He was a noted English philosopher, theologian, biblical translator, reformer, and professor. He was the father of the Lollard Movement. Wycliffe was also characterised as the evening star of scholasticism and the morning star of the English Reformation. Wycliffe's writings in Latin greatly influenced the philosophy and teaching of Czech reformer Jan Hus.

## William Tyndale

Born: 1494 in Gloucestershire, England

Died: 6 October 1536 near Vilvoorde, Duchy of Brabant (modern day Belgium)

Manner of death: He was strangled then burnt at the stake.

Significant Contribution: The Tyndale Bible.

He was a gifted linguist studying at Cambridge. After lecturing around England he worked around Europe but was eventually betrayed in Antwerp. He was tried on a charge of heresy and executed. He was influenced by Desiderius Erasmus and by Martin Luther. A century later the 54 scholars who produced the King James Bible drew significantly from Tyndale's work and translation.
