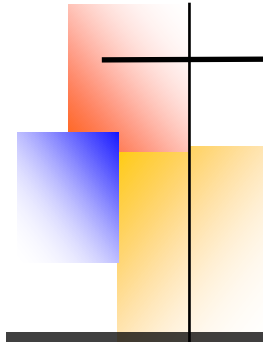

PASS IT ON: LOVING THE NEXT GENERATION

Some have wisely noted one way to judge the quality of a culture or group is the way it treats its children. Healthy cultures around the world love their children in various ways. Indeed, Jesus noted how the vast majority of fathers know how to give good gifts to their children (Matt 7:11; Luke 11:13). The unspoken reason is that they love them. But what does it mean to love them? Love, like faith is a word most people use without meaning the same thing.

Love in the scriptures is not just an emotion like happiness or anger. It is firstly a commitment. We see this in the Hebrew word *hesed* that means God's enduring lovingkindness. The love of God is not fickle or timid. It is constant and strong as so powerfully demonstrated in Hosea amongst other books. We see it in his commitment to the covenant generation after generation despite constant unfaithfulness and rebellion.

The love of God is also redemptive and holy. God's love is demonstrated in sending Jesus to save us from sin, death and judgment and to give us life (John 3:16). Paul reminds us to speak the truth in love (Eph. 4:15). Again we see God's love in action as he works to save his people whether from slavery in Egypt to slavery from sin. More than that his love is at work amongst his people through his Spirit to grow them in fullness in Christ (Col 2:2), in all that is good, godly, loving, just and pure. The goal of God's love is our holy perfection, living with God and one another in selfless service and care without any stain or blemish.

As we think about what it means to love our children, we need to consider these things as we pray for them, listen to them, work for them and provide a model of faith, love and obedience as we and they walk in the footsteps of our Lord who loves us.
