Looking to God

Being a Christian is not always easy. Being part of the church is not always easy. Often it's hard, especially if we take seriously the call to resist the world, the flesh and the devil and struggle with the views and events that are expressed and happen around us. The church in the West has enjoyed a level of influence, respect and consideration that is clearly on the wane. Nonetheless this is not something altogether new. Christians have always wrestled with 'living in the world but not of it', whether living in the Roman Empire, around the time of the Reformation or during a World War.

In the midst of all of this I find myself encouraged and spurred on by these words by James: 'Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Be wretched and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you' (James 4:7-10). We look to God and pray for the wisdom and courage only he can give in facing the future.
