

EUTHANISIA - A QUESTION OF CARING?

In our State Parliament we know a Euthanasia bill is being discussed and will be introduced to Parliament. It's a practice I am essentially opposed to, a practice grounded in a philosophy of despair. Nonetheless the issue of great suffering at the end of one's life is a real question for many. We will all die and for some of us it may well be quick and painless and for others quite the opposite. At what point does suffering become seemingly meaningless suffering, the hardest kind for anyone to endure? Too many elderly people are placed in nursing homes by their families and all but forgotten, too many people suffer and die all but alone.

It's at this point as we think about presenting the Christian view point on this topic that we need to check ourselves. We speak about being a caring and loving community, looking out for one another in our times of need. Paul in 1 Timothy reminds his young protégé about how such care is to be managed and prioritised. This is the time when we need to stand up and heed the word of John in 1 John 3:16-18 "This is how we know what life is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters. If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person? Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and truth."

Will we be there for each other in our time of need, young or old, wealthy or poor, man or woman or will our business and personal priorities be the more urgent concern. The time is coming when we will need to put our money where our mouth is in such matters as this for the glory of God and the sake of our Lord Jesus Christ.
