Throughout this next portion of 2 Samuel we read of many people speaking, advising and counselling Absalom and David in their respective positions, some in God's name. It reminds me that even today in the wider world and in the church we hear much of wisdom but how much of it can we rely and trust in.

I know over the years one of the great blessings I have enjoyed in the church is the wise and godly counsel of others here at Karrinyup and elsewhere. We fall into the trap at times in our individualistic world that we don't need help from others when they actually would be a great blessing.

Nonetheless we need to be cautious. The scriptures are clear there is wisdom and foolishness and in David's sons we see incredible foolishness. There is also earthly and spiritual wisdom. True wisdom is grounded in the fear of God, in an awareness of God's laws and will and of the lessons we can learn from the world and each other. Any claim to wisdom that is not grounded in God is not wisdom at all!
