### True Security

The number of modern songs about love is overwhelming. What is striking is that few speak of the security of true love, communicated in the bible through the language of faithfulness. Song of Songs encapsulates it in the occasional refrain 'my beloved is mine and I am his and his banner over me is love.' It's a phrase that takes us back to the Garden of Eden, of Adam and Eve together without fear. Nonetheless they disobeyed God and that peace became anxiety.

As a result God's love is then seen to be gracious and restorative. As God is love, he is also light, perfect, holy, radiant light. In a world where love has become permissive and sentimental we see God's constant, enduring and relentless love that seeks to bring forgiveness, reconciliation and wholeness. Love has a goal that is growth in the likeness of Christ, for all that is good and godly that culminates in the person and work of Christ.

We see this in the encounters of various women with Jesus in particular the Samaritan woman and the woman caught in adultery. Both find in Jesus grace and acceptance but as Jesus exposes or sees their brokenness and sinfulness they find in him forgiveness, reconciliation and salvation. Songs reminds us that love is stronger than death and Jesus overcame death for us that we might live in God's love and light.

### Church Matters

In June 1988 the church building was finally completed (not without a few hitches like a coral coloured carpet being ordered to blend into the colour of the walls and a bright blue carpet, curiously with the same ID number, arriving). The fittings, doors, kitchen and painting were all completed by parishioners.

On the day of the commissioning, seating was laid out right up to the kitchen hatch. Even then there was standing room only.

The church was named Saint Francis of Assisi. Later it became Karrinyup Anglican Church as many in the wider community assumed that we were a Catholic church which proved to be quite confusing. There are a couple of references to the original name, in the church. The cross of St. Francis is incorporated in the stained glass window at the front of the church, and a small ornament of St Francis, brought back from Assisi by an early parishioner, is in a Perspex box by the sliding door on the Eastern side of the church.
