

# **Fellow-workers Together**

May years ago an acquaintance in Carnarvon described my role as that of saving souls. Paul reminds us that it is not we but God who saves souls, who transforms lives by his divine power. Nonetheless as I think about today's reading it reminds me of the need to avoid two extremes when it comes to ministry and mission.

The first is to forget such work is God's. We can make mission an enterprise accomplished through our efforts alone, through various methods. So too often, like the Corinthians church, different approaches to ministry and mission then lead to division.

The second is to forget God, in his grace, has called us to be co-workers in his mission. As his witnesses each has a part to play as partners with one another and with the Lord. People don't come to faith by being mysteriously zapped by God. At some point someone has spoken to them about God or shown kindness in Jesus' name or the like. God in his wonder then uses such things to bring about and nurture faith. This is our call and our task, as we trust in him.
