

PUT ON A HAPPY FACE!

For years now with regard to our children especially we're to do our level best to be positive and affirming rather than negative and derogatory. We've discovered that the effect of one harsh word is equivalent to a half dozen kind ones. We all know the difference it can and does make.

Nonetheless we are becoming aware of a growing problem, of what could become generation 'hopeless', a generation so lacking resilience, so fragile and protected that any criticism no matter how small or justified, any failure, even trivial has devastating consequences. The pendulum has swung too far from a screaming sergeant major on the one hand to a tepid Mary Poppins on the other. So now we use whatever tools we can to protect ourselves or get our way.

Proverbs reminds us of the importance of grace and generosity as well as truth and discernment, of living a life grounded and trusting in the God who made us, sustains us and directs us. His character in his love, goodness and righteousness, his actions in creating, protecting, guiding and judging are the foundation and the model for our lives as we live together in a wider world.
