

### Baptism, Faith and Love

When people are baptized, they or their sponsors when they're young make some declarations and promises. They are declarations of repentance and faith in God and in Christ. Jesus' baptism is unique in that he had no need to make such declarations, Rather it is the Father who declares his faith in and love for his Son whose baptism is his commissioning. His ministry begins in earnest as he begins the journey to the cross and empty tomb. God the Father has no doubt Jesus his Son will be faithful in every act of his mission to the end.

Paul describes Jesus' faith and resurrection in Romans as Jesus' baptism, dying for us and rising to new life, when we put our faith in him, that baptism, that forgiveness, that life becomes ours. Baptism signifies our joining and participation in the family, the life of God, Father, Son and Spirit. We are loved as Jesus is loved and loves.

That means we can be assured of the love of God the Father as Jesus was. He too is well pleased with us, not because of our efforts and own righteousness, but because of Jesus' righteousness in which we are clothed. As he was always with Jesus no matter what he endured, so he is with us. We are never alone, indwelt and empowered by God's Spirit who indwelt and empowered Jesus. I don't know what this New Year will bring for us but Jesus' baptism reminds us we go forward in his strength and with his help and assurance.
