## A STARK CONTRAST

One of the stark contrasts we see through the book of Revelation appears here in the sequence of plagues sent upon mankind. That contrast is between the willful sinfulness of human beings and the merciful justice of God. We see it in the way the people of the world respond to the dramatic signs they experience, the way they treat God's people and the painful consequence of those actions.

In chapters 6, 9 and 16 after all that happens the people of the world, they refuse to repent and turn to God and to Jesus. These events remind us that sin is not just something we do, it's not just about our actions. It's also about our attitude, our wilful refusal to live by faith in God and living according to his will. We think we know better than God like the stubborn child unwilling to listen to his parents or elders. But it's only when we begin to appreciate the depth of our stubbornness that we can marvel at the mercy and grace of God. The blood of the lamb cleanses all who come in faith no matter what they've done and it is they who will experience the forgiveness and new life he gives when we lean on him and not our own foolishness.
