A FOUNDATION FOR AUTHORITY, LAW

AND JUSTICE

The last fifty years has seen the unfolding of a social, existential and moral crisis, a crisis of authority. Institutions political, legal, civic and religious have been weakened, abandoned and often rejected when they have been seen to be exceeding or abusing their authority. More and more the authority of the self seen in self-expression and personal autonomy and freedom are the supreme measure.

Nonetheless authority in any human community, organization or institution is a given whether we like it or not. The question then becomes on what basis we claim authority to speak and act, even at times through force? For some such authority is the purview of a few on the basis of status, wealth or heritage. In a democracy authority is given as a mandate from the people. The danger becomes that of glorified mob rule.

Ultimately true authority is grounded in principles that are timeless and transcendental. Today's portion of Deuteronomy reminds us that even those principles are ultimately grounded in the eternal and timeless God, in his character and actions. Then and only then can we truly speak of love, truth, freedom and justice.
