JESUS TO THE END

In Acts 27 to 28 Paul faces three life-threatening disasters. Throughout each episode he stands as a beacon for the Lord Jesus, standing firm and not just surviving but enabling others to live as well. Implicitly though Paul reminds us of the great mystery that is life and death. He and Peter survive imminent death a number of times while others like James and Stephen promptly die for their faith in Jesus.

The answer to Paul's deliverance lay in the divine visitation he received, called to proclaim the gospel in Rome, the heart of the empire. As we wrestle with such questions of life and death as God's people we need to keep Paul's own words in mind in Philippians: *"But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself. Therefore, my brothers, whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm thus in the Lord, my beloved."* (Phil 3:20-4:1). We look to him.
