The Hope of Heaven

One of those inevitable but difficult questions young children at some age ask is "What's heaven like?" Historically we import imagery from the ancients, the legend of cupid, envisaging people floating about the clouds with angelic wings and playing harps, the assumed instrument of choice in heaven.

The book of Revelation presents us with two visions of heaven that frame the rest of the book's visions. The first is that of heaven in the present and the second that distant day when Jesus returns and heaven and earth join together in God. The vision of heaven in chapters 4 and 5 tell us the following things about heaven.

- 1) The Holy, sovereign and majestic God sits at the centre.
- 2) God is the focus of heaven as the living creatures or seraphs, angels and elders all worship the Almighty for who he is & what he has done.
- 3) The citizens of heaven also worship Jesus, the Lion of Judah and Lamb of God, worthy of worship because of who he is & what he has done, especially in the events of Easter.
- 4) Heaven is the place marked by nothing but peace, order and goodness. There is no hint of evil or disorder in any way. All is as it should be under God.
