

Spiritual Bookends

I find Paul's first letter to the Corinthians an interesting one. When you read almost all his other letters you can divide them into two parts, the first part being doctrinal as he writes about the gospel and some important aspect of Jesus life and ministry. The second part of the book then outlines what that means for Christian living, whether our life together, or the ethical consequences or our mission to the world.

In contrast in 1 Corinthians, Paul's theology, his convictions about the Lord Jesus serve as bookends at the start and finish of the book. The first four chapters, which we will look at over the next few weeks, focuses on the Cross while the lengthy chapter 15 takes us to Jesus' resurrection.

In between we read of Paul's teaching and direction on a number of matters of concern about the Corinthian church. They involve marriage and singleness, dispute resolution, matters of strong conscience, gender relations, church order and ministry and giving. What Paul does though is remind the church that we need to look at such matters through the lens of our crucified and risen Lord.
