

Title: Toxic Deception

2 Peter: A Problem Child in the New Testament (?) Part 3

Today's passage has made many uncomfortable over the years. When we think about heresy we think about the harshness of the Spanish Inquisition, burnings at the stake, the Salem Witch trials and so on. So in reaction when it comes to significant doctrinal difference we find various ways to smooth such matters over as if they don't matter at all. Even more so in the modern world when spiritual and religious viewpoints are seen in purely subjective terms, to state one's opinion too forcefully is simply seen to be arrogant. The danger though is that the baby goes out with the bathwater.

2 Peter reminds us along with much of the New Testament and Gospels truth matters, including spiritual truth. Jesus came making certain claims with regard to his identity and mission. He made it clear to accept or reject him had serious and eternal consequences. To choose to accept or reject Christ is a life-changing decision at every level. This is why theological error needs to be pointed out and rejected. We're not talking about a sincere difference of opinion but a viewpoint that runs completely contrary to the gospel and leads to the arrogance and self-interest Peter writes of and compromises our salvation. The days of inquisitions and star chambers are thankfully past but we continue to resist serious spiritual error that compromises our faith.

One of the regular missions of our church here at KAC to outreach to the wider community is the Foodbank. Food bags are made up each week containing some staple foods, such as: Long-life milk, baked beans, cereal and pasta. A full list of these items is available in the foyer of the church. Those in the community who have a Health Care card are invited to see Karen in the church office on a Thursday or Friday between 9 am and 12 noon to obtain a bag of food. If you would like to contribute to this valuable ministry you can either purchase items on the list (please stick to the sizes of items on the list to allow for consistency and no out of dates items) or make a financial donation in the envelope provided in the foyer.

At Christmas time an extra bag is made up, for each of our Foodbank recipients that contains Christmas fare. The contents could include: a small tin of ham, a tin of fruit, a small Christmas pudding or Christmas cake, mince pies, Christmas crackers and some sweets for the children. Again, if you would like to share with those who are less fortunate than us at Christmas your donations would be most appreciated. Please place them on the large table in the back of the church.

Lastly, if you have any of those large plastic bags for which the supermarkets usually charge 15c, we would appreciate a few of those as we are running out.
