A Challenging World

A work colleague who had been recently married and, I thought, might have been looking forward to motherhood, commented to me one day: "How could I think of bringing a child into a world like this!" The world, to her, was too full of pain and distress to think of passing it on to another generation.

While I didn't agree with her, I can understand the sentiment. Living in the world is to be surrounded by dangers and challenges. The news we access on the television and in the press seems to reinforce the idea that human lives are everywhere endangered, whether by acts of violence, accidents or disease.

When we look into the Bible we find that, when God came to the world in Jesus, he immersed himself in the world just as it was and showed how we can live within it, by faith, in a positive way.

This is the theme of the three encounters of Jesus with the disciples that we see in today's reading.
