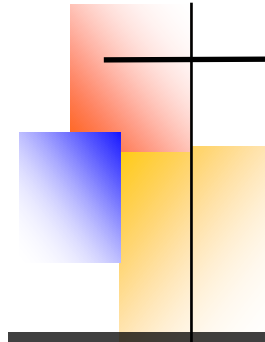

Prophecy and Wisdom in the New Testament

In this portion of 1 Corinthians as Paul writes about the gifts, he writes about Prophecy. Prophets appear in Acts and the gift is mentioned elsewhere. As we consider this gift and ministry in some ways we're taken back to the Old Testament but there are important differences. A key difference is that the heart of OT prophecy is the promised coming of Christ. New Testament prophecy exists in the light of Christ. Many of the OT predictions take us forward to Jesus. We do need to be careful when people then apparently prophesy about the Lord's return and end up disregarding Jesus' own words. Prophecy in the New Testament is small 'r' revelation. God's plans and purposes are fulfilled in Christ and anyone who claims to add to that is on very dangerous ground.

A key point of continuity is that prophets whether in the Old or New were called by God to call people to faithfulness and so often their ministry was one of calling people to repentance and to faith. They reminded people of their covenant relationship with God and how they were to live in the light of that relationship. Sin was an issue for the saints either side of Christ and prophets were gifted in identifying where people were falling short in a particular set of circumstances and how to return to god. They were also called to encourage and strengthen the faithful. Even today these ministries and opportunities are still very much in need as God speaks to his people and we strive to serve him.
