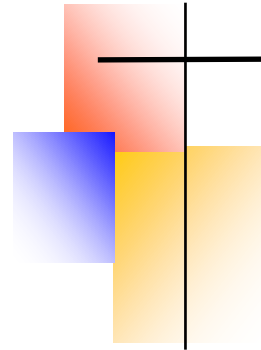

CHANGE, CHANGE, CHANGE

I was going to write this Sunday about the last Sunday in Advent and preparing for Christmas but many of you will have seen the announcement that Archbishop Roger Herft is resigning as our Archbishop and retiring early. His decision is obviously a consequence of the findings of the royal Commission and investigation into his part as the Bishop of Newcastle prior to coming to Perth. At one level I find the news sad, having known the Archbishop and growing in respect for him over many years to the point that he entrusted me with the appointment at Karrinyup. On the other hand for many there will rightly be a sense of relief and that justice has been done.

John at the start of the gospel reminds us that with Jesus coming the Light that is Christ has come into the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it. Truth, Godliness, Love and Integrity matter and the gospel and all associated with it will challenge those forces that promote darkness rather than light. That includes forces within the church as well as without. We look to our Lord who laid down his life for the world now and in the future.
