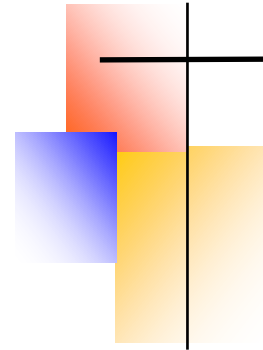

This morning we officially welcome Oliver amongst us during 2017 as a formation candidate with the Diocese. In part this is an opportunity for us to support him as he considers the prospect of Ordained Ministry. It is also an opportunity for Oliver to continue working through what his theological and spiritual foundations are for ministry. What is it that will help him to his continue with his ministry over the years to come given the significant turnover of pastors who burn out here in Australia?

As we've looked at 1 Corinthians 1-4 it's clear that Paul's ministry was grounded first and foremost in Jesus Christ, in the shadow of the Cross, in the hope of Resurrection and in the power of the Holy Spirit. Paul, amongst others, was firmly committed to proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ, building up the church of God into Christian maturity and caring for those in need both within and without. This was their sacred mission, for which they were willing to die, the gift of eternal life they and we have received in Christ that continues to drive, empower and strengthen us as Christ's witnesses in the world.
