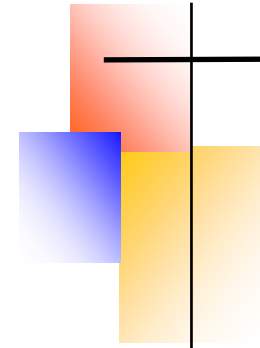

HOLDING TO A HIGH STANDARD

We live in a day an age where ethics has become a matter of personal choice. A generation has been taught to 'trust your feelings', that 'we're free to feel good' and that 'you're special'. Indeed the cardinal sin of this day and age is to be seen to be pushing one's view of morality or ethics onto another person.

As a result we see some young people committing violent crimes with no regret or conscience. Companies and organisations have to formulate codes of conduct and social and collective conduct is overseen through bureaucracy, political correctness and litigation.

Into all of this we read of Jesus' teaching in the Sermon on the Mount. Jesus reminds us that for the Christian i) our ethics are motivated firstly by faith in God, Father, Son and Spirit; ii) they are grounded in God's divine revelation that are the scriptures especially the law; iii) as a corollary they reflect the very character of God in his righteousness, holiness and love and iv) they start from deep within, from the heart devoted to God rather than from the desire to keep up appearances.
