

2 Peter: A Problem Child in the New Testament

When the early church finalized the New Testament Canon, ratifying the books that had been considered scripture by the second century, there were a small number of books that proved controversial and still do. Even by the reformation theologians like Luther and Calvin were uncomfortable with 2 Peter as part of the New Testament Canon. There are three main reasons for this and in the newsletter this week and next we will look briefly at two.

The first is the question of authorship. At first glance the letter itself and tradition suggest the Apostle Peter wrote the book. On closer inspection though the style of Greek is very different to 1 Peter and more refined. Along with that the letter shows a great deal of familiarity with gentile thought and practice yet Acts and Paul suggests Peter's ministry focused on the Jews.

When these challenges arise it is easy to make unwarranted assumptions in order to prove a point either way. Some argue for the Apostle as the author (through a secretary) and others Jude (which I will look at next week) or someone else. The problem is there is so much we don't know about Peter and his life after Acts. There are the various traditions but they are far from full proof. Unless more evidence is forthcoming it is best to assume Peter authored the letter as one who learnt from Jesus and bore witness to his glory (c.f. 2 Peter 1:16-18). Next week we look at the letter's links with Jude.
