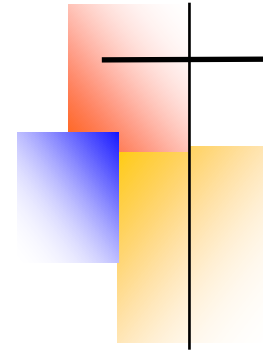

THE WONDER OF CHOICE

One of the profound and important abilities we have as human beings is the power of choice. Day by day we face and make choices about so very much, about matters small and seemingly inconsequential and about matters large and significant. Every so often we make choices that can have a profound impact on our lives and the lives of our family and the wider community depending on our responsibilities and circumstances.

Jesus reminds us at the end of the Sermon on the Mount of the moral and spiritual choices we make that have a significant impact on others and ourselves in this life and the next, choices that resonate into eternity. In today's world such choices are personal, subjective and temporary. We appear to both celebrate and denigrate choice. For some we celebrate it in movies such as 'The Power of One' while for others we are little more than a product of our genes or society or history amongst others. Jesus reminds us both of the power of choice and of its consequences and the most fundamental and crucial of them is choosing our Lord and God.
