

The Ascension – The Power of Hope

Human beings face a multitude of challenges in the world they live that arise from nature, from society and culture and from our relationships. When relationships sour or breakdown or when danger threatens, we often face a choice, to succumb to despair or dare to hope. Hope is a powerful force and motivator for human beings and the lack of it can be devastating. If you are struggling with anxiety or depression or another mental health issue, please seek help as soon as possible. Don't leave it be.

Indeed we live in an age where people are awash in a sea of despair and confusion where, in declaring God dead or completely absent, we stare into the abyss of meaninglessness and darkness and struggle to make sense of so much of the world. Communities are awash in anxiety and depression; fear and confusion and societies are struggling to cope or make any headway in this malaise.

Hope though takes hold of us when we begin to find meaning and see a better future even in the direst of circumstances. The Ascension is God's seal on the life and ministry of Jesus, the King who came to usher in the Kingdom of God marked by faith and love, who will usher in its full presence upon his return. Our hope in Christ lies in our absolutely secure life in him, saved and loved by faith. It also lies in the confidence we have that when the Kingdom of God comes in its fullness, we will be a part of it, living in a world marked by love, joy and peace.
