## Godly Accounting?

The Book of Proverbs reminds us of a constant and all-encompassing challenge, of how it is our faith in God the Father, Son and Spirit ought to impact on and shape **every** aspect of our lives. Often the church is strong on some areas such as sexuality or family but weak on others such as money.

How we deal with questions surrounding money, finances, wealth and poverty has at times been problematic. On the one hand we shy away from such matters whenever possible, spending as simply and cheaply as we can especially on Christian workers. On the other hand on any other day we give little or no thought to how the gospel impacts on our business ethics and practice. Sadly a few years ago Sydney Diocese started playing the stock market with devastating results and here I wonder if we have risked much playing the property market.

Proverbs reminds us of another way, a way I experienced with BCA, of ethical business practices and of a heartfelt commitment to using money not for personal gain or empire building but for the growth of the gospel and the glory of God. May we do likewise!

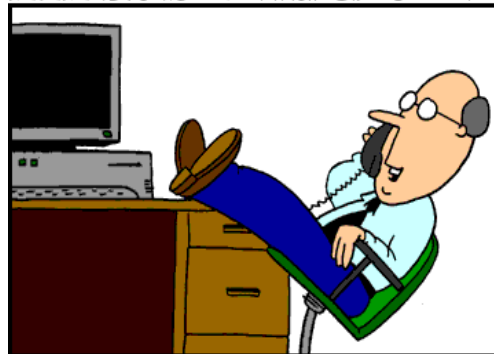
### DESTINY'S DATE: FREE FILM SCREENING
