

What a Week!

We have all had one of those weeks. Holy Week starts with Palm Sunday, the hurrah as Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a donkey. The mood towards Jesus quickly changes for some as he enters the temple and overturns the tables of the moneychangers and others. The synoptic gospels tell us that Jesus spent much of the week debating various matters including his identity and mission with the religious leaders in particular. They tried to trap him and he skillfully answered every trick. Nonetheless by the Thursday night it all began to come to a head as Jesus faced betrayal, denial, abandonment and indescribable suffering. Finally on Good Friday we see an incredible act of injustice as an innocent man dies on a cross. Our Lord's suffering means both God's identification with those who have suffered in such a way and becomes the means of our salvation, his life given as that atoning sacrifice for our sins. The wonder of the week is that death is not the end but rather for all who look to Jesus, it is the beginning.
