SOME CHALLENGES OF THE KINGDOM

As Jesus heads to Jerusalem, the seemingly tragic and yet world-changing goal of his mission, he teaches his disciples, he teaches us about the Kingdom of God, of its character, of its citizens and of citizenship, of its influence and scope, of its supporters and opponents. Last week he challenged his hearers about the priority of God's kingdom, the challenge of putting Jesus at the centre over and above all others including family. This week he challenges his hearers about expectations regarding those in God's kingdom, who respond to trusting God and following Jesus. Those who should have been the first to recognise the coming of God's kingdom, his rule manifest in Jesus were the last and those who were expected to be the last to recognize God's hand were the first. Jesus came to bring restoration, reconciliation, hope and joy, the just, loving and merciful life-giving rule of God but these things were a challenge to the people and powers whose focus was self-interest and power at the expense of others. This is a challenge we still face today as we consider Jesus.
