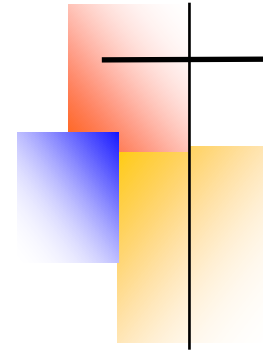

TO THE HEART OF THE EMPIRE

Over the last few years after Easter we've been looking at the book of Acts. Today we come to the end. Over the next couple of weeks we will pick up a chapter or two we missed but today we get to the end. Christianity so easily could have become an obscure Jewish sect, or Jesus a historical footnote, another decent but misguided man with a messiah complex that came to much of nothing.

Instead we are reminded of a faith, a set of convictions that took men and women across an empire, sharing with all their hope and faith in Jesus Christ as the Son of God who died that we might live. Over the centuries, even millennia many have tried to stamp such faith out by a multitude of means. God promised Peter he would build his church and the gates of hell would not prevail against it. Well, here we are, Paul in Rome, the heart of the empire sharing the good news of Jesus for all who want to hear it, even when he's under house arrest. Even in a hardened nation such as ours, it's this hope we proclaim.

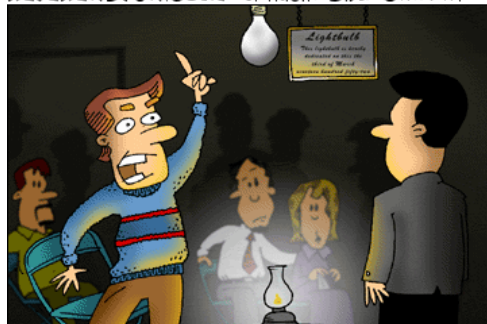
