## The Tyranny of War

Over the next few weeks we will look at the cycles that make up the centre of the book of Revelation. Each cycle tells us something of what life is like for God's people as they live awaiting our Lord's return. The first cycle Ian will take us through is that of war and tyranny, directed in particular towards Christians. One of the challenges for the church has been the one clear political dilemma we face: Christ or Caesar? God's kingdom calls us to a higher loyalty that the wider community at best don't understand or at worst hates and seeks to stop. The state, the community becomes God!

This cycle also reminds us of the madness and fallout from tyranny and war, of famine, pestilence and death. We often mark human history through the lens of empires and war. It is one of the most inexplicable human behaviours. We can't help ourselves as we rage against God, one another and the wider world. At one level we know this but the lust for power takes precedent. Nonetheless there is hope, hope in the coming of God's King and Kingdom, of the cleaning of his saints in Christ and of the day that will come when Jesus brings an end to the madness of conquest and war.
