The One, the Many

Long ago a document called the Diatessaron was compiled at the end of the second century, a historical compilation of the events recorded in the four gospels in order, an attempt at producing one 'gospel'. The Christian Church though has recognized the benefit of four gospels, four perspectives on the person and work of Jesus. They soon became part of the Christian canon because each affirmed the core truths we believe about Jesus as God with us, but each has its own theological emphasis, its own style and its own structure.

I mention this because, in looking at 1 Corinthians, we are reminded again of the nature of the church reflecting the nature of God that is unity in diversity. Our unity is not uniformity and our diversity ideally does not break down into division. We are to be the one body of Christ, whose one Spirit enables diverse gifts. We are a group of people from diverse cultures, families, backgrounds and incomes. At the heart though for all of God's people is the one conviction that Jesus is Lord and in him we find true and lasting unity together.
