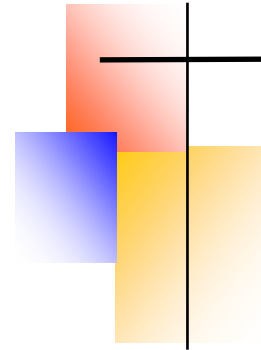

## Evil is not in the Eye of the Beholder

In the postmodern world there are many concepts that our forebears took as a given, as universally true that have been reduced to 'constructs', nothing more than categories of human thought and desire. Evil has been explained in these terms. So we look for something or someone that is the source and explanation of evil like class, patriarchy, greed, fundamentalism and so on. Likewise the concept of good is nothing more than self-actualization and expression. To restrict such things is now evil.

For St Augustine in his book 'the City of God' he reminds us good is constant and eternal and grounded in God's character and actions. Evil is real, powerful but not eternal. Evil can only ever be a twisting corruption or distortion of the good God has made. Everything was made with a divine purpose and goal in mind. Evil twists the good, whether for the sake of power, control and ultimately self-interest. This is part of the reason the religious leaders' charge against Jesus in Matthew 12 is so abhorrent. Jesus came to forgive, redeem and restore. Their motivations on the other hand are grounded in that power, control and self-interest at the expense of the ordinary Jew and all that is good. Such evil as this must always be resisted within and without.
