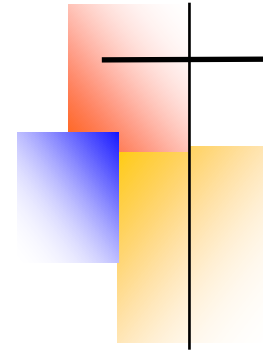

Following Jesus

In the gospels Jesus often spoke about how following him – being one of his disciples – called for total commitment. One such passage is our passage from Matthew 8 this morning – where Jesus speaks to two disciples about the cost of discipleship. He says that they need to know the one who they are following and to make sure that Jesus is the number one priority in their lives.

In Luke 14 Jesus says that nothing, not love for father or mother or even one's own life, was to take precedence over their commitment to Jesus (Luke 14:26-33). If God is going to be focus of their lives – if they are going to love the Lord their God with ALL their heart, All their soul, All their mind, and ALL their strength – then everything else in life – including family and social relationships – our possessions – our careers – and ambitions – must become secondary.

Jesus says (Luke 14:33) that those who do not give up everything you have cannot be my disciples. Jesus calls his followers to be completely committed to a single and exclusive relationship — with him.
