

# A QUESTION OF FOUNDATIONS

Many years ago a friend of mine preached on the Pharisee and Tax Collector, using a scene form Mad Max III, of an arena into which two men went in but only one came out.

We read in today's section of the gospel of two ways to live, of two ways to try and establish a relationship with God. The first is seen in the Pharisee and the Young Rich Man. They use wealth, reputation or their self-proclaimed good works to justify themselves. The trouble is that wealth and power often corrupt, reputation blinds us to failure and when it comes to good works we'll never measure up.

On the other hand the Tax Collector can offer nothing to God except a plea for mercy, no strings attached. He has nothing and is regarded as nothing except by God because of his faith.

Children are another wonderful example of such dependence, trusting in the adults who care for them, who are often great models of faith, faith in Jesus who alone makes the way for us, justifying us when no one else can.
