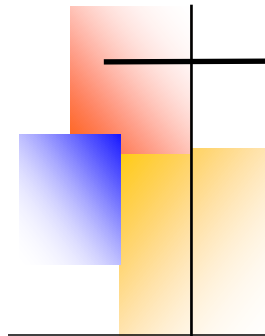

## Churches Together: Giving & Sharing

Every so often political leaders and church leaders make a similar decision when finances get tight. If a budget is to be trimmed, lets trim our foreign aid or our mission giving. Church members raised that very question when we were in Carnarvon functioning on a very tight budget. It's a natural and instinctive response but Paul here in 1 Corinthians reminds us that just as nations are connected to one another in various ways whether economically, culturally, politically and so forth so are church and Christian communities.

The gift to Jerusalem was most likely a monetary gift Paul had collected from churches across Asia Minor to help the church in Jerusalem in a time of need. It was also a way of acknowledging Jerusalem as the birthplace of the Christian faith and of its Jewish origins. Though Acts suggests the gift fails to accomplish its desired intention it continues to remind us of the links churches have across space and time. We support missions and churches here in Australia and overseas because we are united in the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Today we welcome back Bec from her time in the Middle East and we'll hear something of the work of Tear Fund Australia as it cares for people in material need overseas. They remind us of an invisible but indissoluble connection, that link of fellowship grounded in our crucified and risen Lord and in the gift of the Holy Spirit. One of the ways we can acknowledge and strengthen these links is through our giving and gifts.
