Self-Control or Focus

If I were to ask you to list the fruit of the spirit Paul mentions in Galatians, which ones come to mind first? Love, joy, peace are all self-evident and are mentioned constantly in the New Testament. This last week I've been reminded of one of the oft-overlooked fruit that is self-control. Peter writes about it in 1 Peter 5:8: 'Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.' As Disciples of Christ we're called to be focused, focused on God, on the Lord and living lives in service of him in a godly manner. It can mean taking the time to discern what it is the Lord calls us to in a particular matter or ministry and to commit ourselves to it, putting all other distractions aside. There can be many distractions in a variety of forms in ministry that the devil will use. Pray God continues to enable the self-control we need to be serving him as he calls us to here in Karrinyup.

ROSTERS 2016

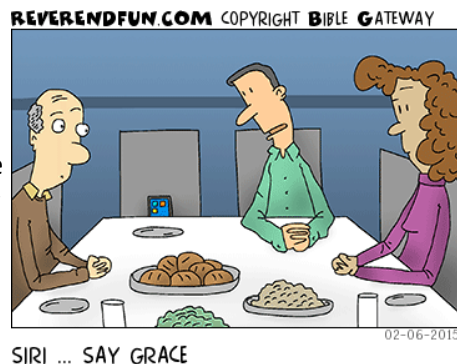
We will be updating the rosters for this next year for the Sunday Services. Please think about how you can help out with tasks such as morning tea, counting the offertory, reading and greeting in particular.
