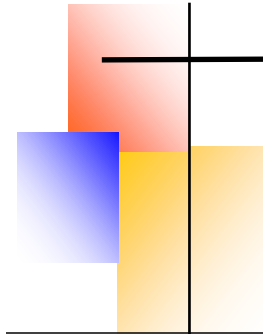

### An Uncomfortable Assumption?

Today as we look at the Cross as the means by which Jesus justifies and sanctifies us we can only truly understand and appreciate these doctrines if we acknowledge with heart and mind an uncomfortable truth. It is a truth I think that has led to the first of these doctrines and the corollary idea of penal substitutionary atonement here in Perth and elsewhere into question.

The reason for this discomfort is that these doctrines are founded on the understanding that human beings are inherently sinful. In our stubborn persistence to assert our authority over and above God's, asserting ourselves as little 'gods' who know better than he does our relationship with the sovereign and holy God has been ruptured and leads only to death and judgment. An abyss stands between God and humanity that seems unbridgeable and unfixable.

Nonetheless, humanity has found lots of ways by which we seek to justify ourselves before God and to find ways by which we can think of ourselves as saints on our own terms and not his. This is why the story of Babel is more important than we realize. Humans are always seeking ways to make a name for ourselves or to bring restoration to the relationship on our terms; in such a way that even God must say yes. The problem is it is simply not possible and that judgment is inevitable.

This is why the tax collector's confession in Luke 18 and David's confession in Psalm 51 are so instructive. They realise there is absolutely nothing they can do to justify or save themselves. That is something only God can do and does so by sending Jesus to give his life in our place to save us from death and judgment.
