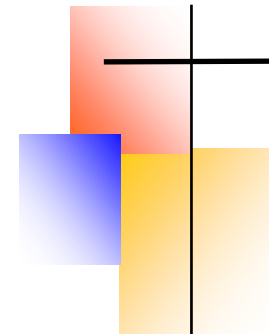

Old Church — New Life

24th and 25th December

Where are you going?

Today is a busy day; this week a busy week. We baptize two children this morning then our choir will sing over the road as we continue celebrating Christmas. Finally in today's reading Peter takes us forward to the Lord's return and the end of this age. These three things though are all connected in Christ.

Baptism firstly is an event we pray will be a key point of transition for these two children. The promises their parents and godparents make express the hope they will one day decide to follow Christ and by faith take their place in the kingdom of God. For the moment that kingdom is not an obvious kingdom. Rather it is descriptive of God's rule and centrality in the lives of those who believe in Jesus and laid all other things aside.

2 Peter 3 reminds us though that the day will come when that kingdom will not be hidden but will become dramatically visible as the present order, the kingdoms that are, marked by decay, self-interest and death will come to an end. Through dramatic language, Peter reminds us the present order wracked by sin will cease to be. Sin and evil and death will be no more.

Christmas is where this all begins as the King of God's Kingdom enters into the world, born a baby in a provincial country town surrounded by family, shepherds and magi. God became one of us in order to save us and today is a day to commit to whether this future is ours and experience that joy, life and hope in this age and the age to come.
