An Enduring Kingship

Today's portion of 2 Samuel is the high point of the book. In many ways it is one of the high points of the entire Old Testament as God makes a Covenant with David and bestows on him an incredible promise of a never-ending dynasty. At first glance though we need to acknowledge this would seem to be impossible. Historians speak of regal dynasties all over the world and of the various houses of England going back to William the Conqueror and beyond. The Carolingian Kings descended from Charlemagne as now a distant memory. In the present we see a third generation rule North Korea but in the end they will not endure. No kingdom ever does and ever can.

So how can we speak of David's enduring dynasty? Notable messianic Psalms such as Psalm 2 and 110 remind us that it is because David's great Son is also God's Son, not just in name but also in his very being. The early Christians recognised Jesus' messiahship in part in his divinity as God with us, the Word of God come amongst us to save and shepherd us as no other leader can.
