THE QUESTION OF TOLERANCE

What we tolerate and how as a society has seen significant changes over the last two decades. Where we enjoyed a lively but civilized dialogue in matters of economic and social policy almost all views are tolerated and accepted, if not celebrated. Yet people, whether individuals or groups are not tolerated and even vilified when they make 'exclusive' claims spiritually or ethically with regard to others. The language of tolerance has become increasingly aggressive as political correctness gives political force to silence one's opponents rather than engage in the dialogue we did in days gone by, threatening our liberal democracy.

How then do we proceed as Christians? What we can't do is proceed from a position of arrogance. Rather we start from the platform of grace. We understand that we are all made in God's image and so we treat one another with respect and tolerance whatever we believe. Secondly our view of the world is grounded in God's revelation in Christ and his word, in which we can have great confidence, and in the righteousness he gives us undeservedly in Christ. We are indeed pilgrims on a journey, calling others to join us as we look to God in our lost world.
