

## The Servant King

Traditionally the Anglican lectionary gives the preacher a choice on Palm Sunday, to read one of the gospels' accounts of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, riding a young donkey, as people threw their cloaks and palm branches before him, or to read one of the Passion narratives, the accounts of Jesus' trial and crucifixion. Together they make up the series of events by which Jesus' mission comes to its climax. Jesus from early in his ministry made it clear that these events were a part of God's plan of salvation for Israel and the world, whatever the motives of others.

Indeed Jesus and the Apostles understood his mission as that of God's chosen Messiah, the great descendant of King David who comes to bring in God's kingdom and Israel's restoration. That long held hope came with so much expectation by many in Israel, the king who would come and overthrow the Romans and re-establish Israel. Instead Easter speaks to us of the Servant King who came and laid down his life for us to secure our salvation as he died in our place and rose from the dead, the life-giving Son of God.
