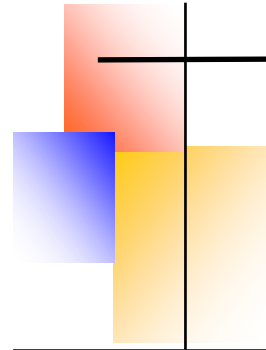

CONTRASTS

Throughout human history human society and behavior have been viewed and considered through the eyes of contrasts, of dualities, of light and dark, good and evil, love and hate, truth and deception, heaven and hell. Such contrasts were grounded in the conviction that they reflected an ethical and moral universe, brought into being by God.

With the rise of the enlightenment and modernism 250 years ago the philosopher Hegel suggested that when we wrestle with such contradictions, we begin to see them in light of a greater whole, a spectrum that diminishes the contrast. Light and dark become shades of grey for example. The world was always changing, evolving and developing.

More recently such contrasts are seen as little more than constructs created by people, often in the interests of gaining and keeping power over others. They are to be challenged and overthrown. The inherent reality of the contrasts are denied but the language is used politically and culturally to advance particular agendas.

These views contain truths worth our consideration but the reality is that the contrasts still describe a reality where human beings turn their back on the Holy God with all the trouble that ensues and requires a savior, Jesus Christ.
