

The Love of the Father

Today we look at Jesus' baptism. As we think about the events of Jesus' life, they inform our faith in two important ways. The first is that it is through Jesus' person and work that we are saved. Here his baptism is the commissioning by his Father for his unique mission that will culminate in hid death and resurrection, empowered by the Holy Spirit as the Son of God, the Eternal Word.

Jesus' life also provides the model of the Christin life and our human existence. The Father tells Jesus and the crowd that, in essence, this is his Son whom he loves and is proud of. We all desire to be loved and affirmed, most especially by parents, to hear such heartfelt words as these.

The great difference is that unlike the Father and Son our relationships are marred by sin, by misunderstanding, failure and so on. How often we need the grace to also say sorry as parents and children. When such forgiveness or affirmation is not forthcoming, we can still turn to our Heavenly Father in Christ who calls us as co-heirs with Christ, loved and affirmed in him.
