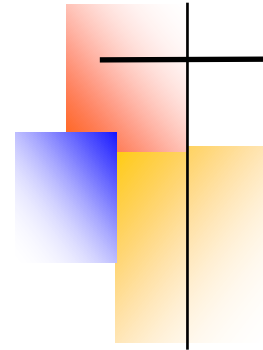

### JESUS: SOMETHING OLD, SOMETHING NEW

Part of today's passage generated questions very early in the church's history as to the relationship between the Old and New Testament. The Apostles and early church leaders realized Jesus completed and fulfilled the Old Testament, which was his Bible, in ways undreamt of.

Before long the gospels along with the writings of the Apostles were as authoritative as scripture (e.g. 2 Peter 3:15-16). They realized that the promises of the Old and all associated with it were fulfilled in Christ and the gift of the Spirit to the church.

Nonetheless two main dangers arose. The first was to reduce Jesus to another Jewish prophet and no more and Christianity. The other more serious error arose with Marcion who argued that the God of the Old Testament was different to and inferior to the God of the New. So he rejected the Old Testament and a good deal of the New. In theological liberalism much the same is done, a canon within a canon based on scientific rationality over and above faith. Jesus teaches us otherwise, that all God's promises find their 'yes' in him (2 Cor 1:20).
