

## The Ascension – Fact or Fiction

Over the next two weeks, we're going to look at the Ascension of Jesus, that is his return to heaven to his Heavenly Father. But as we look at the Ascension it's an event that at first glance is simply unbelievable. The Biblical record tells us that 40 days after Jesus rose from the dead he and the disciples went to the Mount of Olives where they saw Jesus literally rise into the sky and disappear into the clouds, minus a cape and blue tights.

Jesus' departure serves to highlight his return to heaven. We're not talking about another place within this universe but rather we're talking about that place where God is. It's that transcendent reality from which Jesus the Son came where God rules without hindrance, where all those who dwell in heaven experience nothing but light, love, peace and joy. There is no darkness, there is no selfishness, there is no discord. All trust in, worship and serve the sovereign God in absolute harmony and purity.

Nonetheless, the choice is ours. We can either believe the historical testimony of the apostles recorded for us in the gospels and in the book of Acts. They saw Jesus rising into the sky and they also saw and heard the angel who appeared just then asking them why they were looking up. Now they were to wait for the gift of the Holy Spirit for their mission, knowing one day that Jesus would return from heaven in much the same way as he left there when he would come to judge the living and the dead and usher in the new creation, heaven on earth where all who have come in faith can experience this new and eternal life.
