A Lesson in Reading

This last portion of the book, the picture of godly woman, reminds me of one of the dangers in reading the Bible. She's pictured as a woman who works hard while the husband sits around with the elders at the gate. In some countries today men do just that gambling their money. Rather I think this is the equivalent of the town council meeting where the leaders of this community gather to discuss the life of the town. The woman's husband is one such leader and his colleagues can only marvel at the wise and gracious wife he's been blessed with.

As we read this picture we also need to keep in mind how it functions within the book. This is the conclusion, an epilogue that brings the discussion on wisdom and folly to a close. The noble wife exemplifies so many of the descriptions of wisdom we've seen in the book, like that faithfulness, grace, diligence and good business sense. Like Christ she is a person who looks out for others, for her family and the wider community rather than only for herself. In this she is a model for us all.
