

Why was 1 John Written?

1 John was written due to groups causing tension in these churches. The two reasons given are that they deny Jesus is the crucified and risen Son of God and they have willfully mistreated other Christians. Over the centuries scholars have wrestled with what it was that led to this.

The first possibility is a form of early Gnosticism, a group of beliefs that came out of Platonic thought. Essentially the spiritual was good and the physical was flawed if not evil. As a consequence sin and righteousness was seen as relatively unimportant.

Docetism is a similar phenomenon that was applied to Jesus. It emphasizes his divinity while denying his essential humanity. So he could not die on the cross for our sin nor does he truly understand our struggles.

Another possible group that John had to deal with were Judaizing Christians as some did in Galatia, emphasizing law keeping over faith. They also suggested that Jesus was a man and nothing more. Rather Jesus is neither an unreachable ideal nor a mere teacher. He is God's son who makes the way for us through his death and resurrection.
