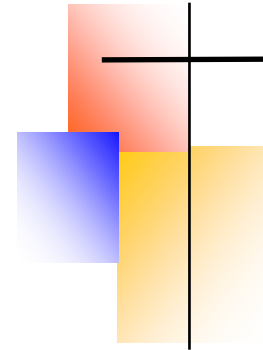

CHALLENGING WISDOM

I recently read an article that expressed the concern that in some ways the Internet is only enabling the fracturing and breakup of our society. We risk only connecting with others through the web who see the world just as we do, increasingly reinforced in our particular view of the world and the erroneous views of those who think differently. In days gone by such a possibility was limited due to our broad education system, robust but respectful public discourse and a media committed to the truth rather than a particular agenda.

Over the next few weeks we will look at the book of Proverbs, a book that lay at the heart of the wisdom tradition that developed in Israel. It reminds us that wisdom begins and is grounded in the 'Fear of God'. Proverbs though also reminds us that knowledge and wisdom are nurtured in the context of community, under the tutorship of godly mentors, through the wisdom and insights of experience, of friends and family. Such wisdom as this finds its full expression in the life, teaching and ministry of Jesus and those he nurtured and encouraged as they walked together in faith.
