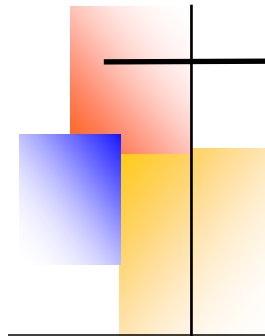

## The Gifts Today?

In recent weeks there has been a controversy about the former Dean of Perth's interim appointment to the Anglican Centre in Rome. The controversies over his views are nothing new but they are problematic, to say the least. As we look at Paul's teaching on the gifts of the Holy Spirit we do so mindful that they are the gifts given to the Church by the crucified and risen Jesus. So if he did not physically rise from the dead all of this is in vain. The gifts are given to enable the church in its witness to the world of the gospel, our glorious Lord and to enable our service of and care for one another as we grow in the likeness of Christ and Jesus continues to act through the church.

This is why the ministries Paul lists in Ephesians that focus on God's word are so crucial. There is an ongoing debate about whether all of the gifts are current today such as tongues and prophecy or whether they ceased with the death of the apostles. I think they are still active and relevant especially in places where the gospel is breaking new ground in the lives of unreached people and communities. On the other hand, we can unrealistically expect too much, too often. How often we see God at work in the mundane and ordinary that should not be underestimated. What matters is that the gifts are given to equip and enable us as we serve God faithfully in Jesus' name.
