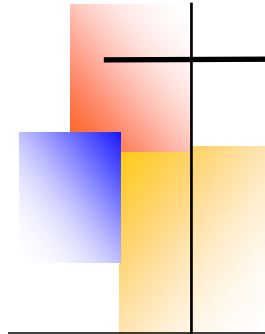

## Beyond Race

At first glance in today's gospel reading we see Jesus being seemingly racist as for a time he turns his back on this Canaanite woman's desperate plea. The Canaanites were an old enemy and her background made her the epitome of an unclean gentile who becomes a profound example of faith. In a world where tribalism is making a comeback in response to the multicultural push and as many rightly reject racism as an acceptable attitude this story reminds us of the greater thrust of the gospel that ends with the great commission. Israel was only ever meant to be a light for God to the gentiles, an example of humanity at its best and noblest. Though that didn't come to pass at one level, it does in Jesus Christ. More to the point as we see beyond the gospels the good news of Christ starts to work its way across the Roman empire as people from a plethora of racial and cultural backgrounds are united in Christ. The picture culminates in the scene in Revelation where John sees people from across the world in heaven, united in Christ, praising God.

So much of what the world tries to do to end racism either only goes so far or actually becomes counterproductive, stirring up even more anger and pushback. We need to acknowledge the variety of cultures we see across the world that arise for a multitude of reasons while also acknowledging the reality we are all human, the same blood running through our veins. The reasons we can truly affirm the latter is because we are all made in God's image and because Jesus came to save all those who would come to him in faith. This astonishing woman is one of the first examples of this incredible miracle.
