Old Church — New Life

.A World of Pain!

Today's portion of 2 Samuel is a stark contrast to what has been as David does something so incredibly destructive and evil that the kingdom is almost torn apart. In chapters 11 to 15 we see it all, like a bad reality TV show, a train wreck we can't take our eyes off. We see sexual abuse, murder, tragic loss, a broken family and an all but broken kingdom. After the initial rebuke of David by Nathan, David's family runs amok and we see judgment inflicted upon the house of David as the 'summer kingdom' begins to unravel.

Nonetheless though these are dark days where we see human beings at their worst, this is not the end. The counterpoint to these chapters is found in Psalm 51. Unlike Saul, David heeded the prophetic rebuke regarding his sin. In showing genuine remorse and repentance we see this man experience the great gift of forgiveness. He will have to suffer the consequences of his actions in this world as we all do, but the relationship is still intact. David's story is ours to varying degrees and like him, our hope lies in the forgiving grace of God in Jesus Christ.
